Solid Waste Diversion Plan requirements. An owner shall submit to the City of Hollister Planning Department, a debris recovery plan prior to the issuance of the building or demolition permit. The debris recovery plan must include the following information: (a) A description of the management methods planned to be used for all types of construction and demolition debris (e.g. reuse, recycling or disposal), (b) The name of all service providers and/or facilities to be used for debris management, (c) An acknowledgment that the owner understands the requirements of this Chapter, including the requirement for demonstrating achievement of the diversion requirement. Diversion requirement means at least 50% by weight of the total construction and demolition debris is diverted. Meeting the requirements of the local C&D Ordinance also means the project is in compliance with the State's CA Green Building Code (<http://www.bsc.ca.gov/Home/CALGreen.aspx>)

By signing below, I acknowledge that I am responsible for complying with the requirements of Chapter 15.04.045 of the City of Hollister Code related to recovery of construction and demolition debris and that lack of compliance may result in delays in issuance of building/demolition permit(s), hold on final inspection(s) and/or fine(s).
