

## ***Be a Good Neighbor***

When you allow your cat to roam freely outside, you not only expose your pet to potential harm, but you also affect the people and animals in your community. Please be aware that not everyone in your community appreciates cats and may regard cats on their property as unwelcome visitors. Please prevent your cats from creating nuisances with your neighbors by keeping your pets under control at all times.



## ***Where Do I Take A Stray Cat?***

If a stray cat has recently appeared and you think it may be lost, abandoned or feral contact the Animal Shelter. Check and see if a "lost report" may be on file for a cat matching the description of the one on your property. Your call may reunite them. If you are able to catch the cat, you can:

- Take the cat to the Animal Shelter.
- Call the Animal Shelter and local Veterinarians to see if anyone is missing their cat.
- Bring the cat into your home while you try to locate the owner.
- If you are unable to catch the cat, you can humanely trap the cat and bring it to the Animal Shelter. Animal Shelter staff will remove the cat from the trap.

### ***Cat Trap Rentals***

If you are unable to catch the cat the Animal Shelter has humane traps available for the trapping of feral or nuisance cats. Cat traps are available to the public on a first come first serve basis Monday – Friday 9:30 -12:00 and 1:00 – 5:00 (hours subject to change). There is a \$47.00, check only, refundable deposit and a rental fee of \$10.00 for the first day and \$2.00 per day each day thereafter.
