
Phillip Ray Orabuena, Lead Muralist

Ray was born on June 7th 1984 in Gilroy, CA at a hospital that is no longer there. He lived with his parents in Hollister but was raised by his grandparents and aunt in San Juan Bautista.

He first started drawing with his aunt at a young age after school every day instead of doing homework.

After barley graduating high school, he joined the U S Marines. From 2004 to 2007, he served 3 deployments in Iraq and was assigned to run convoy security with CLB 5 military police detachment. He also served in the 3rd civil affaires group in Fallujah and up-armed hundreds of military vehicles. Iraq is where Ray's painting and stencil work started. Since his return to Hollister, he has led 3 mural projects with a 4th one currently in the works. He also does paintings for the California State Parks of Monterey, CA and San Juan Bautista, CA.
