

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER ADOPTING
A POLICY FOR NAMING PUBLIC FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, the City of Hollister has an established system of park, recreation and public facilities, and

WHEREAS, this system of park, recreation and public facilities will be expanding with future growth and improvements, and

WHEREAS, public park, recreation and public facilities are typically named after geographical locations, historic events or persons who have made contributions to the City of Hollister, and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollister currently does not have an established policy on naming and renaming public facilities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollister should establish uniform criteria and a process for naming and renaming public facilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Hollister hereby adopts the following criteria for naming and renaming public facilities:

1. To identify the facility by geographical location of the site or immediate area.
2. To identify the facility by historical features of the site or immediate area.
3. To identify the facility after a person who has made distinct and significant community contributions to the well being of the City of Hollister.
4. Other relevant factors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Hollister hereby adopts the following process for naming and renaming public facilities:

1. City staff will develop a written application process that will allow the public to submit recommendations to the Parks and Recreation Commission for the naming or renaming of a public facility
2. The public will be notified of the need to name a public facility and will be encouraged to submit requests based on the criteria for naming public facilities outlined above.
3. The Parks and Recreation Commission will then review any applications and, if necessary, meet with the proponents of a facility naming or renaming prior to making a recommendation to the City Council.
4. The Parks and Recreation Commission recommendation will then be reviewed and acted upon by the City Council.


