

# CALGREEN C&D RECYCLING COMPLIANCE INSTRUCTIONS

CALGreen Code requires 65% of Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste to be recycled. For more information on CALGreen Requirements visit: <http://www.calrecycle.ca.gov/LGCentral/Library/canddmodel/instruction/faq.htm>

## STEP - 1

1. Complete C&D Recycling Plan "Before Permit" section. The C&D Recycling Plan "Before Permit" must be completed prior to issuance of your permit. Staff will keep a copy and you keep a copy of the Recycling Plan.

## STEP - 2

1. Contact the C&D recycling services you plan to use for your project.
  - a. See 'Approved Haulers' List. All haulers must have a signed Non-Exclusive Franchise Agreement to do business in San Benito County.
2. Recycle 65% of C&D materials to meet the state requirement.
3. **KEEP ALL WEIGHT TAGS** for recycling and disposal to document the 65% recycling.

## STEP - 3

1. At conclusion of your project, complete C&D Recycling Plan "Post Construction Report". See instructions on form and Sample Recycling Plan.

2. Attach all recycling and disposal WEIGHT TAGS to the Recycling Plan.
3. Staff will review and verify your Post Construction Report and WEIGHT TAGS for the 65% verification prior to issuing your final inspection.
