- Permit shall be conspicuously posted on the recreational vehicle and/or boat in a manner that reasonably insures visibility (e.g., next to license plate)
- The recreational vehicle and/or boat may be parked in the driveway temporarily without the required setbacks provided the recreational vehicle and/or boat does not encroach upon the public right-of-way (e.g., sidewalk)
- The recreational vehicle and/or boat shall not be parked on the public street if it creates a hazardous condition.
- The recreational vehicle and/or boat shall not be stored in a manner where any portion of the vehicle or boat encroaches into the public right-of-way or, if parked within the roadway, encroaches further than reasonably necessary into the public-right-of-way. (e.g. slides can not be extended into street or sidewalk)
- Recreational vehicle and/or boat parked on the roadway shall have traffic cones of no less than 12 inches in height placed on the roadway within 5 inches from the front and rear corners of the recreational vehicle and/or boat that protrude furthest into the roadway.
- At no time, shall there be electrical extension cords or any other connection placed across the sidewalk or other public areas.
- Any violation of these conditions shall result in the revocation of the permit and/or a citation for violation of section 10.10.040 of the Hollister Municipal Code.
- Issuance of permits shall be limited to 4 permits per month and a maximum of 15 permits during the 12-month period preceding the most recent permit request
